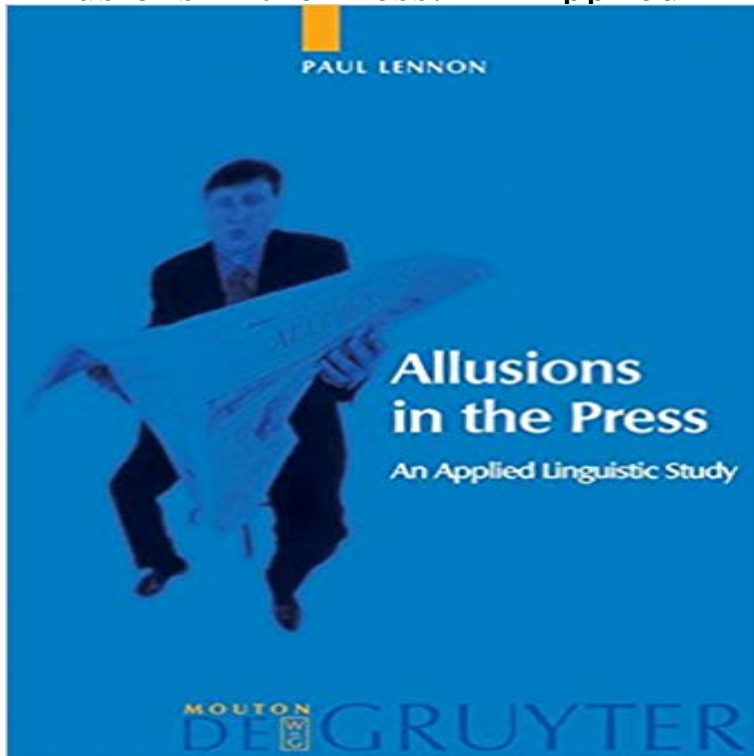


Allusions in the Press: An Applied Linguistic Study
