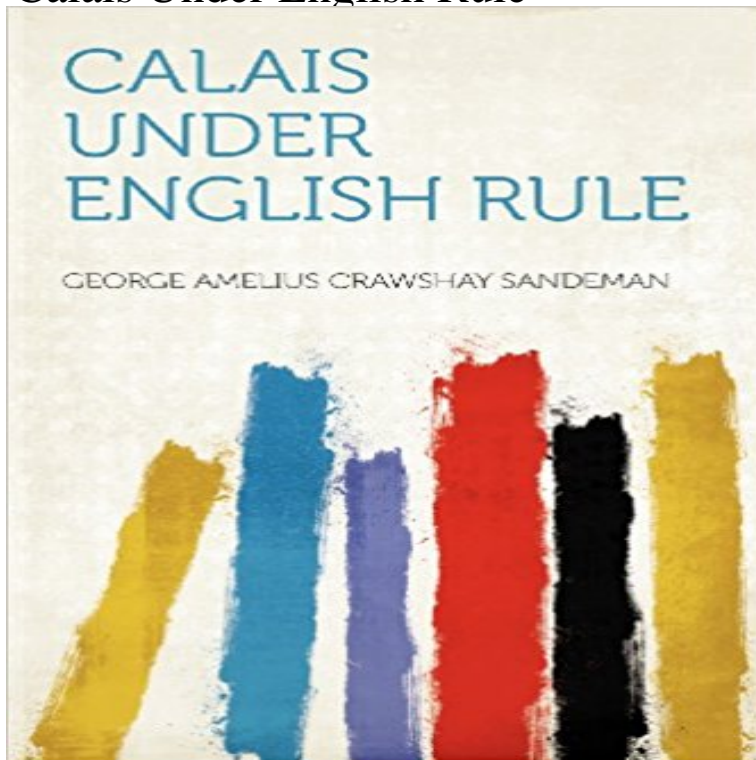


## Calais Under English Rule
