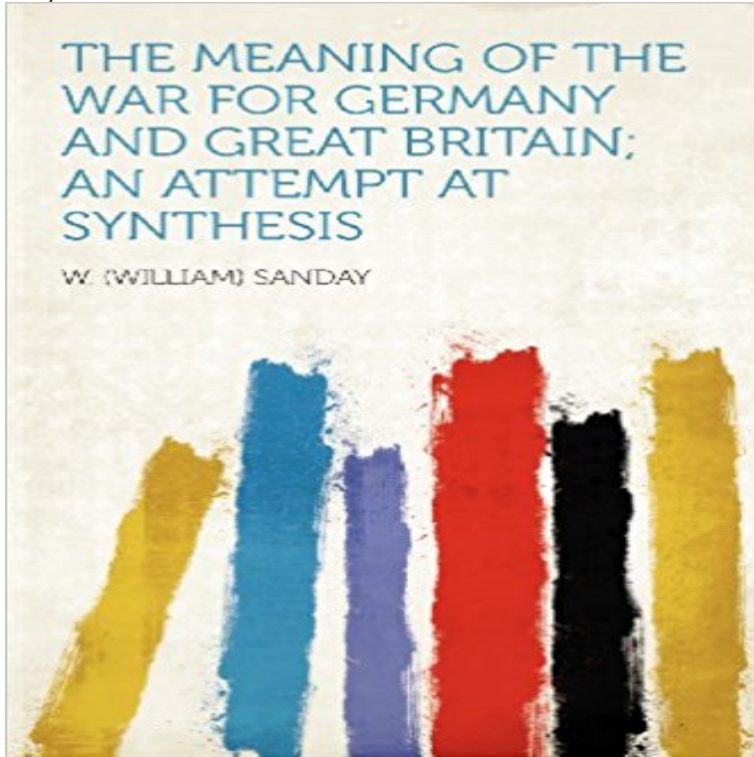


The Meaning of the War for Germany and Great Britain; an Attempt at Synthesis
