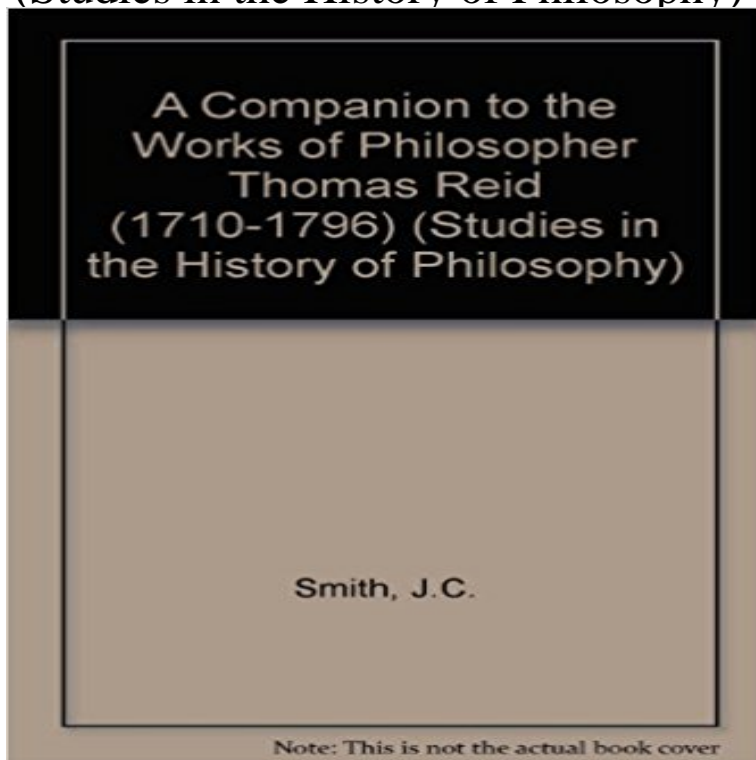


## Companion to the Works of Philosopher Thomas Reid (1710-1796) (Studies in the History of Philosophy)
