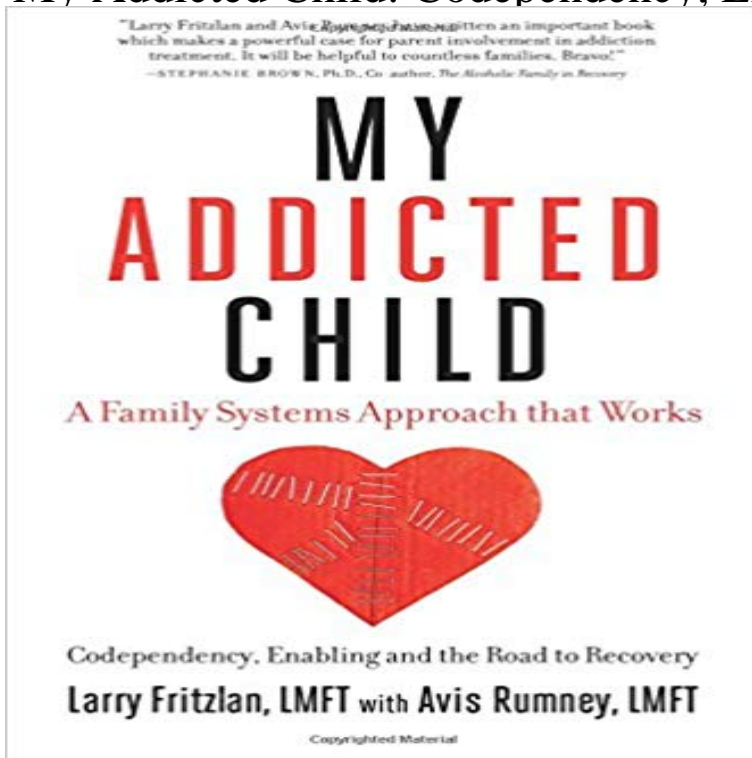


My Addicted Child: Codependency, Enabling and the Road to Recovery
