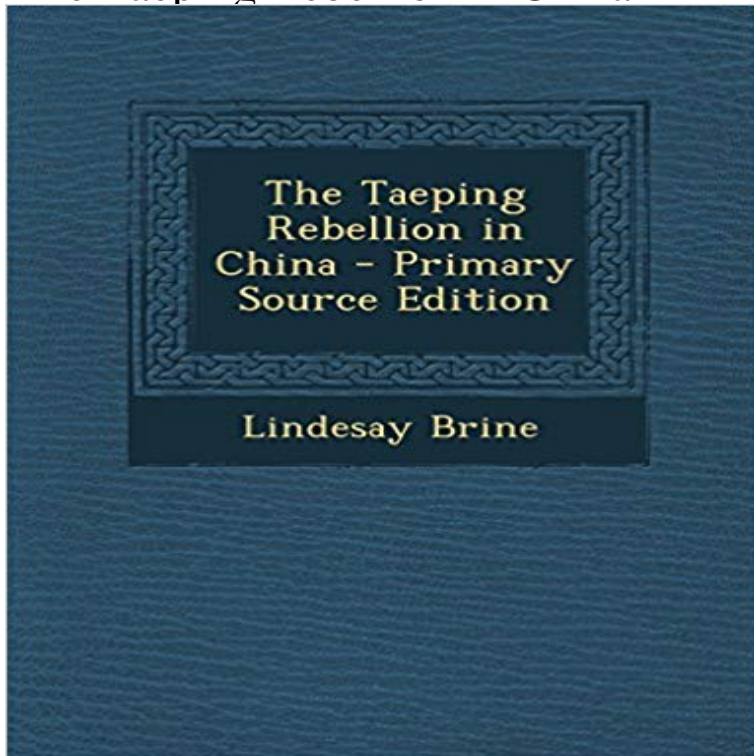


# The Taiping Rebellion in China
