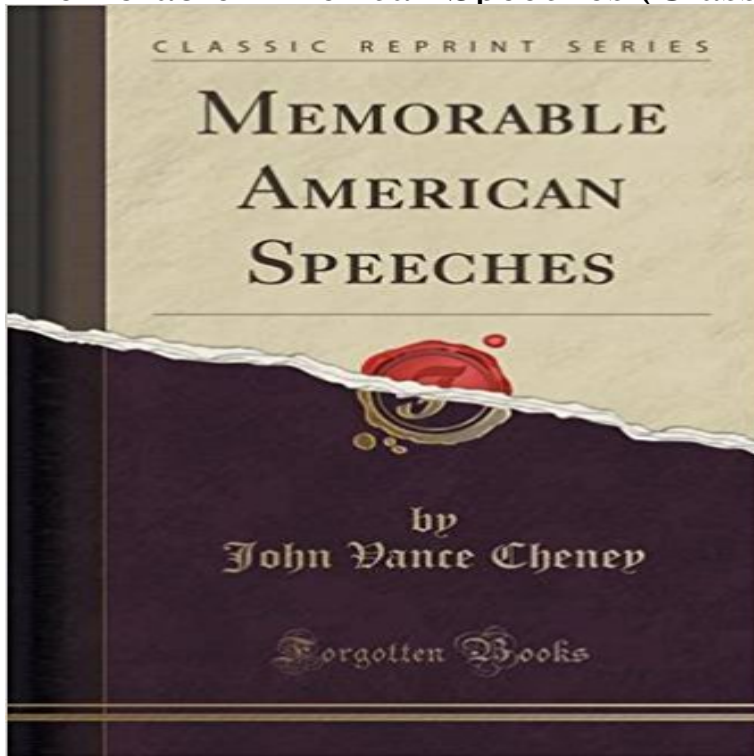


Memorable American Speeches (Classic Reprint)
