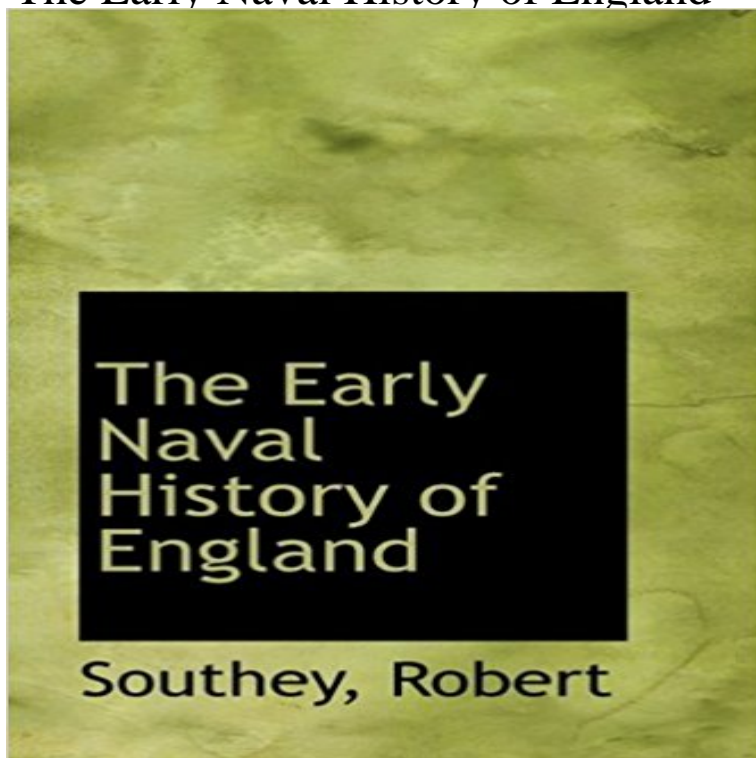


The Early Naval History of England
