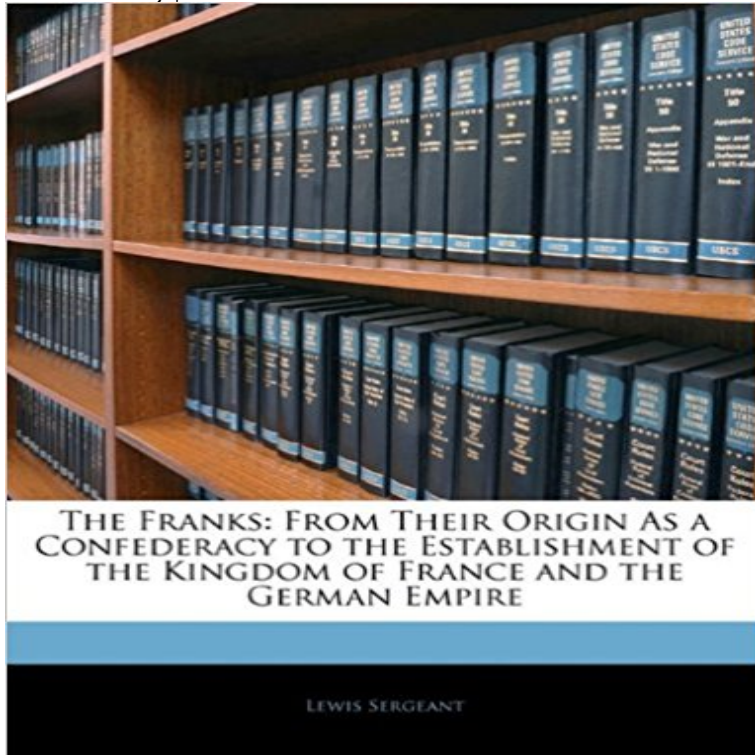


# The Franks: From Their Origin As a Confederacy to the Establishment of the Kingdom of France and the German Empire
