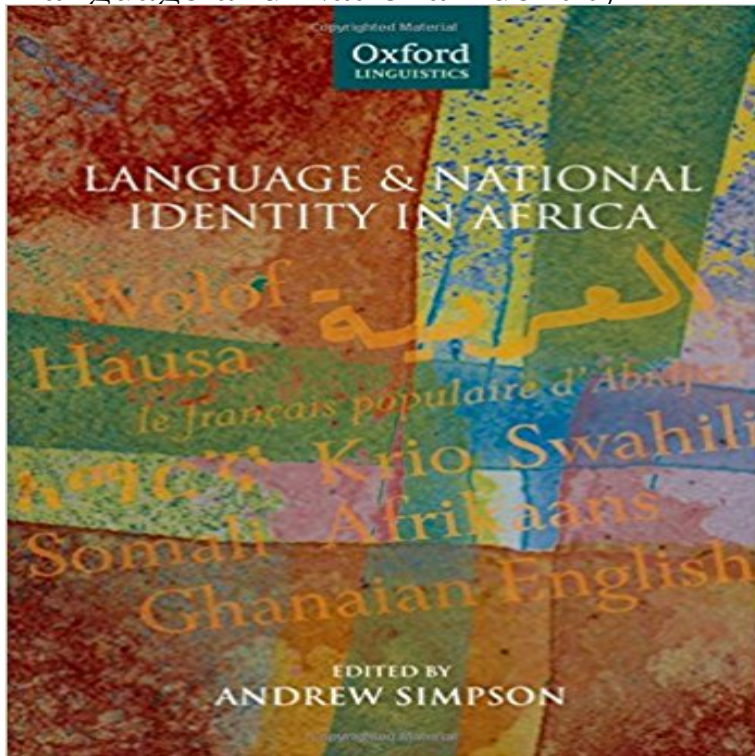


Language and National Identity in Africa (Oxford Linguistics)
