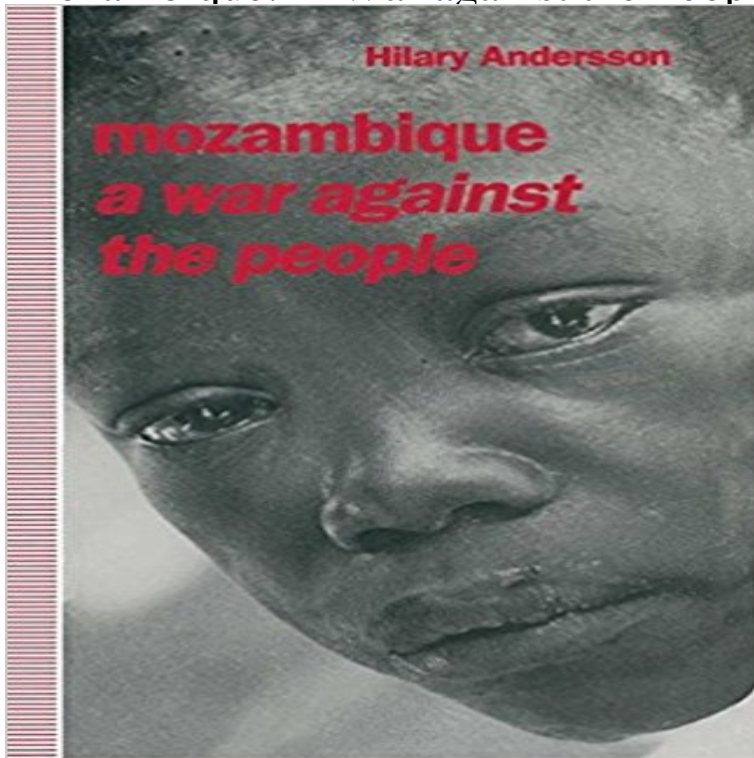


Mozambique: A War against the People
