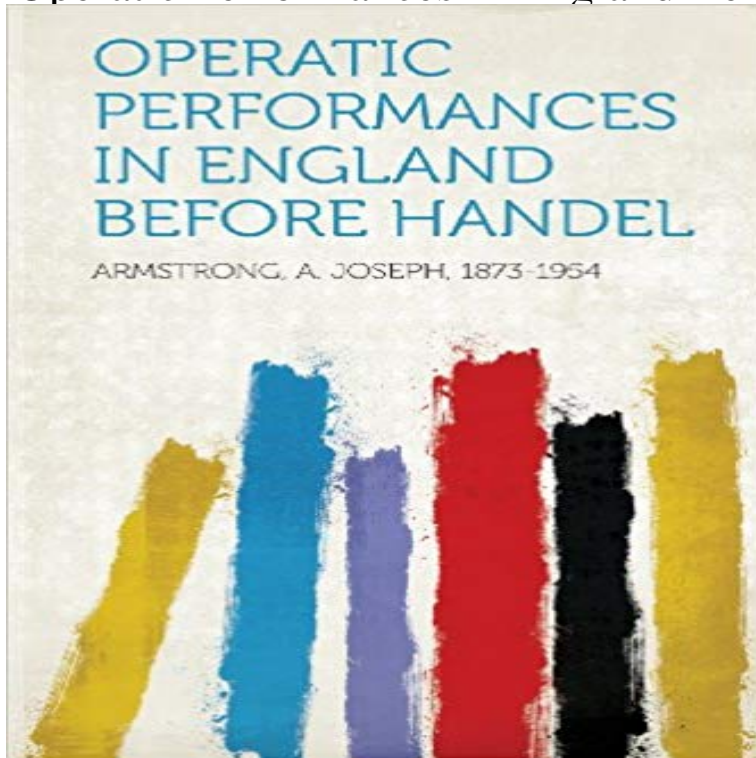


Operatic Performances in England Before Handel
