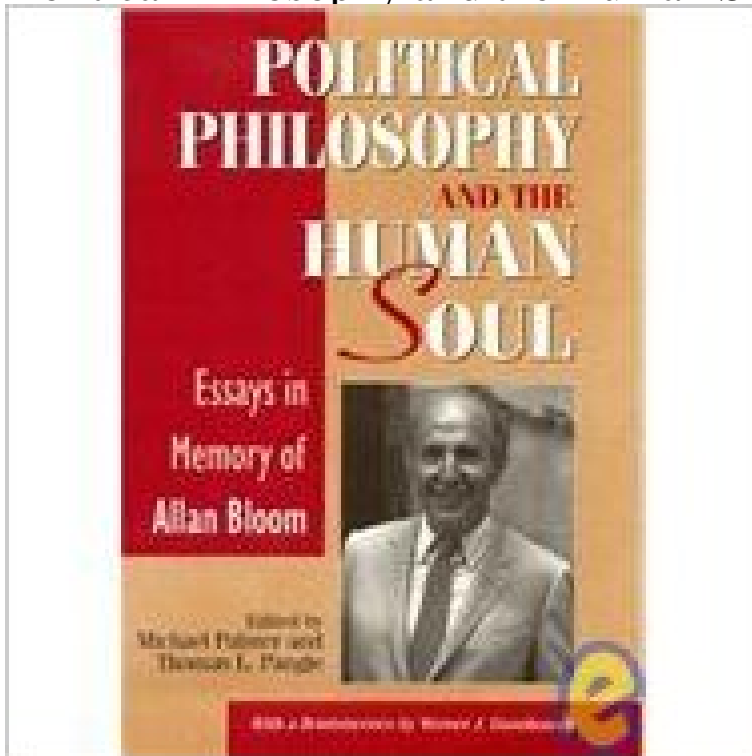


## Political Philosophy and the Human Soul
