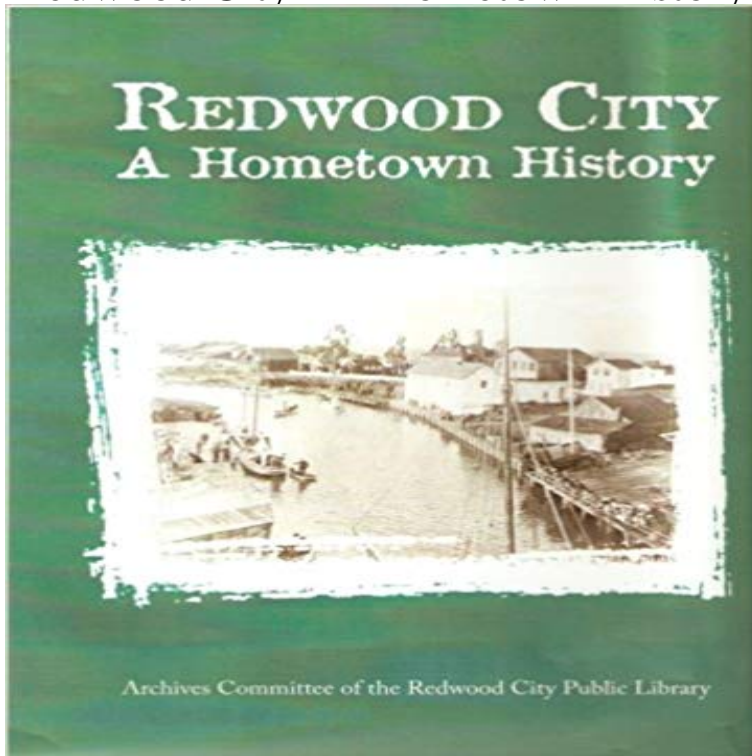


## Redwood City - A Hometown History

From early pioneer days with rural stagecoach transportation through the railroad and automobile, Redwood City has been core of the San Francisco Peninsula.
