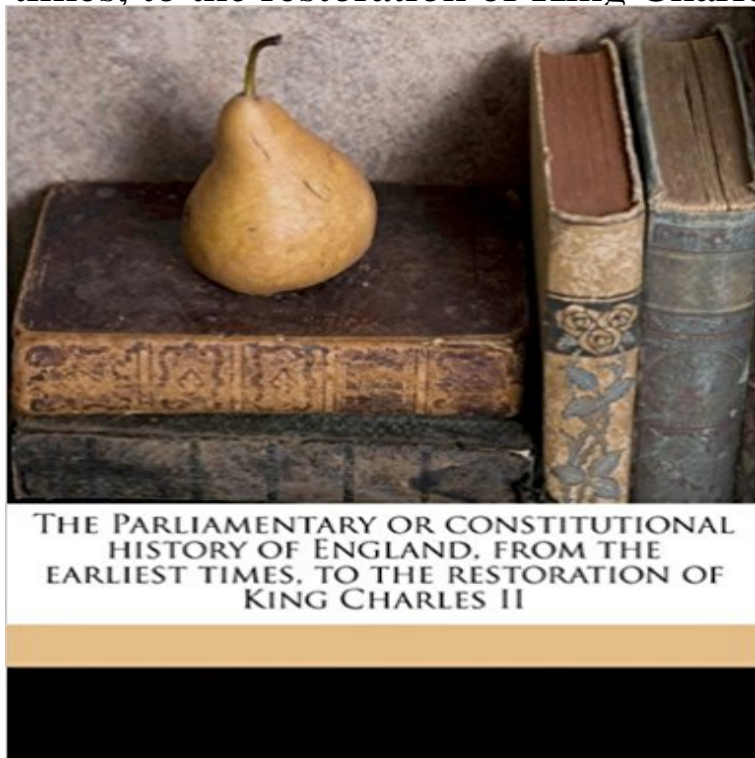


The Parliamentary or constitutional history of England, from the earliest times, to the restoration of King Charles II Volume 19
