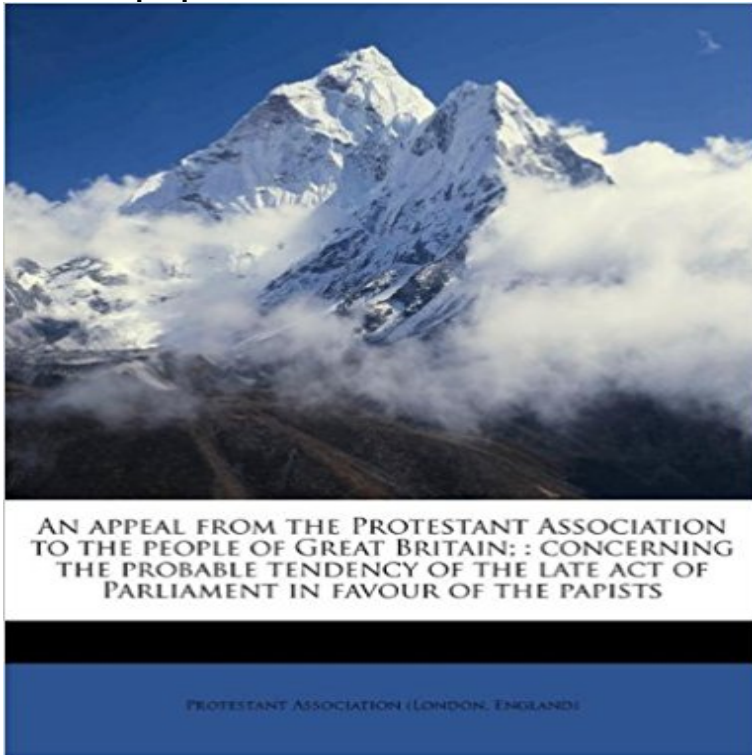


An appeal from the Protestant Association to the people of Great Britain;; concerning the probable tendency of the late act of Parliament in favour of the papists
