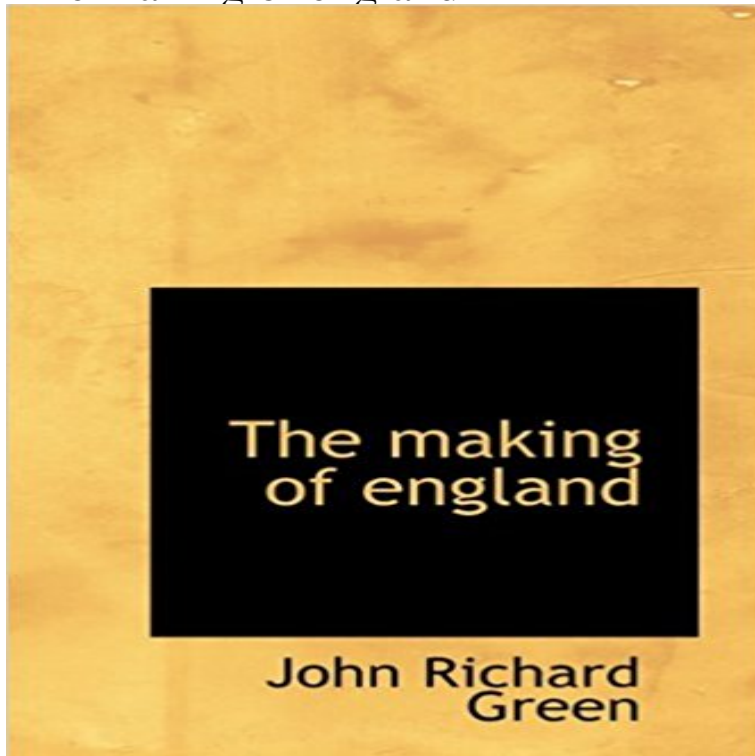


The making of england
