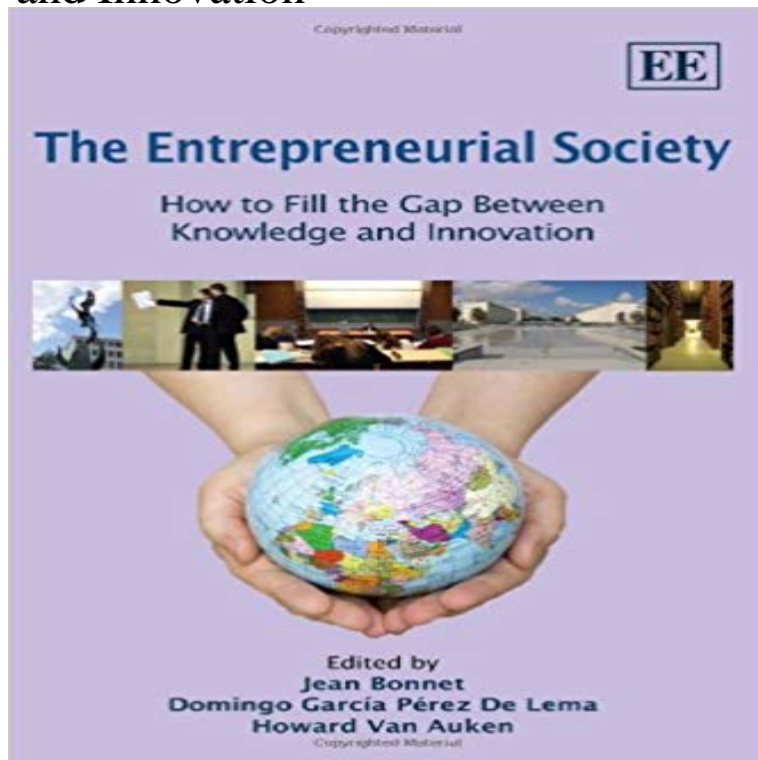


The Entrepreneurial Society: How to Fill the Gap Between Knowledge and Innovation
